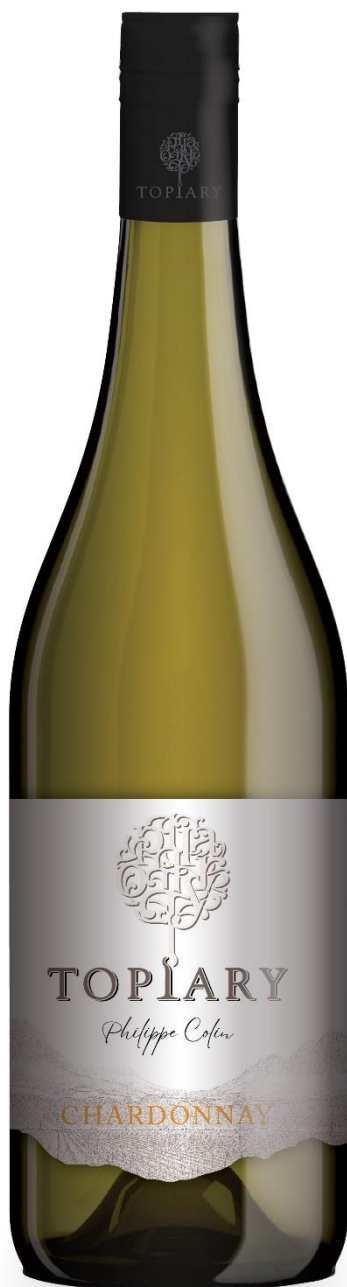


CHARDONNAY

Appellation - Franschhoek, Western Cape Province (South Africa)

Owner - Philippe Colin

The estate

Surface area - 64 ha

Area in production - 17 ha

Density of plantation - 2500 vines /ha

Average age of vineyard - 24 years

Terroir – Sandy soil from quartz erosion (Sandstones)

Vineyard management – IPW Certified, sustainable agriculture

Manual green work, mechanical soil work

The winery

Harvest date - February 09th 2023

Production - 2 900 bottles

Yield - 10,5 hL / Ha

Grape variety – Chardonnay 100%

Harvest – By hand in crate, sorting in the vineyard then on table

Vatting – French tradition, in temperature-controlled stainless-steel tanks. Direct pressing at cold. MLF in barrel

Ageing - 12 to 16 months in French oak barrels of 500L

The wine

Bottling date - 14th of November 2024

Alcohol - 13,0 %

pH - 3,55

Residual sugar - 1,86g/L

Tasting notes - Bright golden colour. Complex nose marked by dry apricot flavour and pear with hint of hazelnuts. Fresh mouth on grapefruit zest with a saline ending.
